

I've always felt a strong connection to my surroundings — a sense of place — and our corner of Iowa has provided me with more than an abundance of natural beauty and artistic inspiration. My take on flyover country? It's about being out of doors, listening, looking up, and delighting in the winged creatures flying overhead.
